TRIP TO London B

I am delighted to confirm that the London trip is now fully booked. There will be approximately 20 students in the group and members of staff. The details of the trip are as follows:

- Monday 15th in school 8.30 until 2.40pm (normal school times)
- Student to arrive at Beckfoot Oakbank at **time TBC** or meet at Keighley Station Tuesday 16th July **TBC**
- Arrive at Royal National Hotel, details included in your pack
- Cost includes: All travel/transport, bed and breakfast hotel accommodation, evening meals, visits to the Science Museum, a flight on the London Eye, performance of the Lion King, self guided tour of the Tower of London plus some free time for sight seeing and shopping.
- Return to Keighley Train Station **time TBC** – Please collect your son/daughter from Keighley train Station .
- Friday 19th July in school 8.30 until 2.40pm (normal school times)

The weather in London in July can be very hot, please make sure your child takes sunscreen and a hat and told to drink plenty of water. We will be spending a lot of time on foot and therefore appropriate footwear is recommended.

As the cost only includes breakfast and evening meal, students will need to bring sufficient cash to cover lunches during the day and any additional spending money they require for their personal use. All monies taken are the responsibility of your child and as such we recommend that only a small amount of spending money is taken, we accept no responsibility for loss of spending money. We will also need to know if any of the students taking part in the trip have any special dietary needs, this information should be filled in on the medical and contact form included in this pack.

There may be additional supervised sightseeing time for students during the trip but this will only take place after a full risk assessment has been made of the circumstances at that time.
