Enrichment Week Activity - Multisports

I am delighted to confirm details of your son/daughters enrichment week activities. There will be approximately 200 students taking part in the activities and 20 members of staff. These activities are free and details of the activity are as follows:

- **Monday 15th July 8:30 – 2:40pm – 8:30-9:30-** Registration and team building activities.
Focus of the day- ***Traditional Sports*** including football, netball, rugby, rounders and hockey.
- **Tuesday 16th July 8:30 – 2:40pm – 8:30-8:40-** Registration
Focus of the day- ***Alternative Sports*** including Dodgeball, Kick Ball, Rockitball, Unihoc and American football (end-ball)
- **Wednesday 17th July 8:30 – 2:40pm – 8:30-8:40-** Registration
Focus of the day- ***Athletics (indoor and outdoor)*** including jumps, throws, sprints, distance running and relays in a Sports day style
- **Thursday 18th July 8:30 – 2:40pm – 8:30-8:40-** Registration
Focus of the day- ***Fun day/Mad sports*** including Capture the flag, Bodgeball, crash mat rounders, Man hunt, Danish Long ball
- **Friday 19th July 8:30 – 2:40pm – 8:30-8:40-** Registration
Focus of the day- ***Options day*** including selection of traditional sports including football, netball and rounders but also some alternative and mad sports too.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible sport like clothing must be worn including appropriate footwear to be able to compete in sporting activities. The weather in July is likely to be hot, and some of our activities will be outdoors. We recommend at these times students has some sun cream, water bottle and a hat. It would be highly recommend to have a waterproof jacket, which can be stored safely in a changing room when not required. During the school day break time will be 10:30 – 10:50 and lunch will be 12:10 – 12:40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
