Enrichment Week Activity – Lights, Camera, Action

I am delighted to confirm the details of your son/daughter's enrichment week activities. There will be approximately 12 students taking part in these activities and 2 members of staff. The details of the activities are as follows:

- **Monday 15th July** – Register in Room G28 at 8.30am Prompt – students will then take part in drama, music and dance workshops during the day, finishing at 2.40pm
- **Tuesday 16th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in Room G28 at 8.30am Prompt – students will then take part in drama, music and dance workshops during the day, finishing at 2.40pm
- **Wednesday 17th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in Room G28 at 8.30am Prompt – students will then take part in drama, music and dance workshops during the day, finishing at 2.40pm
- **Thursday 18th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in G28 workshops to take place until 12 noon when they will then walk to Keighley train station to catch the Leeds train, performance of Grease starts at 2.30pm and finishes at appx 5pm, we aim to catch the 5.41pm train back into Keighley arriving at appx 6.08pm.
Students can either bring a packed lunch to eat on the train or purchase food at break time to take with them. Parents will need to collect their children from the station at 6.10pm.
- **Friday 19th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in G28. students will then take part in drama, music and dance workshops during the day and will be filming workshop performances at school, finishing at 2.40pm.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible clothing must be worn. The weather in July is likely to be hot, and some of our activities will be outdoors. We recommend at these times students have some sun protection cream and a hat. We will also be spending a lot of time on foot and therefore appropriate footwear is recommended. During the school day, break time will be 10.30 – 10.50 and lunch will be 12.10 – 12.40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
