Enrichment Week Activity – Action, Animation, Adventure.

I am delighted to confirm the details of your son/daughter's enrichment week activities. There will be approximately 12 students taking part in these activities and 2 members of staff. The details of the activities are as follows:

- **Monday 15th July** - Meet at Keighley train station 9.00am sharp. Bradford Media Museum – Activities include: Animation workshop, IMAX, lunch, Wonderlab and free time in the museum. Arrive at Keighley station at 3.45pm where students will need to be collected. **Students will require a packed lunch for this day.**
- **Tuesday 16th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in F30; Introduction from visiting illustrator, Conal Deeney; Illustration – creating a 'fantastic beast'; Photoshop - design skills, editing and amending 'fantastic beast'.
- **Wednesday 17th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in F1. Graphic novel project.
- **Thursday 18th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in F1. Animation project – making a time lapse of model making.
- **Friday 19th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Registration in F1. Animating models.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible clothing must be worn. The weather in July is likely to be hot, and some of our activities will be outdoors. We recommend at these times students have some sun protection cream and a hat. We will also be spending a lot of time on foot and therefore appropriate footwear is recommended. During the school day, break time will be 10.30 – 10.50 and lunch will be 12.10 – 12.40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
