Enrichment Week Activity: Tour of Yorkshire

I am delighted to confirm that the above activity is now fully booked. There will be approximately 84 students taking part, split into 4 groups of 21. Your child has been allocated to **Group A**, there will be 2-3 members of staff with each group. The details of the activities are as follows:

- **Monday 15th – Royal Armouries** - Arrive at school at 8.30am prompt go to room F38 to register. Students will then walk down to Keighley train station and depart for Leeds. We aim to catch the 2.18pm train back which is due to arrive in Keighley at 2.43pm, students will need to either make their own way home, or be collected by parents. A packed lunch will be needed.
- **Tuesday 16th – Skipton Castle** - Arrive at school 8.30am prompt register in F38. Students will then walk down to Keighley train station and depart for Skipton. We aim to catch the 1.59pm train back a which is due to arrive in Keighley at 2.08pm, students will need to either make their own way home or be collected by parent. A packed lunch will be required.
- **Wednesday 17th - National Media Museum** -Arrive at school 8.30am go to room F38. Students will then walk down to Keighley train station and depart for Bradford. We aim to catch the 1.46pm train back which is due to arrive in Keighley at 2.21pm, students will need to either make their own way home or be collected by parent. A packed lunch will be required.
Thursday 18th – Salts Mill & Roberts Park - Arrive at school at 8.30am go to room F38. Students will then walk down to Keighley train station and depart for Saltaire. We aim to catch the 1.40pm train back which is due to arrive in Keighley at 1.51pm, students will need to either make their own way home or be collected by parent. A packed lunch will be required.
- **Friday 19th** - Normal school day – please go to room F38.

The weather in July can be very hot, make sure your child takes sun cream and a hat and told to drink plenty of water. We will be spending a lot of time on foot and therefore appropriate footwear is recommended. Enrichment week is a non-uniform event.
