Enrichment Week Activity –TextileTastic

I am delighted to confirm details of your son/daughters enrichment week activities. There will be approximately 10 students taking part in the activities and 2 members of staff. Details of the activity are as follows:

- **Monday 15th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in room G5 Pupils will be taught how to use the sewing machine and use a fashion pattern template. Pupils will cut out fabric and make a pair of pyjama shorts.
- **Tuesday 16th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G5 textile Artist Harriet Lawton is coming to school to run a workshop using pattern and her textile work as inspiration.
- **Wednesday 17th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G5, pupils will learn how to create a screen print and create a design to add to a plain T-shirt to match their pyjama bottoms.
- **Thursday 18th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G5, pupils will leave school at 9am by school minibus to attend a workshop in Hebden Bridge, leaving Hebden at 2pm to be back for 2.40pm. Pupils will be visiting the Word of Mouth building and be taught a range of skills by Indian Embroidery artist Saima Kaur. Pupils can bring a packed lunch with them or will have the opportunity to buy lunch in one of the many café's/bakeries in Hebden Bridge. Pupils are more than welcome to bring spending money.
- **Friday 19th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G5, pupils will have the opportunity to complete any unfinished projects. They will have time to create a Mexican themed charm tassel and cactus plant or choose to create a piece they have designed themselves.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible clothing must be worn. During the school day break time will be 10.30 – 10.50 and lunch will be 12.10 – 12.40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
