- **Friday 19th July 8.30 – 2.40pm** - Register in F5 – Students will then walk down and back to Cliffe Castle (Group 2). Group 1 will be taking part in activities in school.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible clothing must be worn. During the school day break time will be 10.30 – 10.50 and lunch will be 12.10 – 12.40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
