### Enrichment Week Activity - "Teenage Zombie"

I am delighted to confirm details of your son/daughters enrichment week activities. There will be approximately 12 students taking part in the activities and 2 members of staff. The details of the activity are as follows:

- **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G6. Ripper Masks – talk about their work, construction and influences, history of SFX presentation, design of zombie using face template, patch test of materials.
- **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G6. Clay construction of prosthetics and plaster casting of prosthetics.
- **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G6. Cast cleaning and using laytex to create prosthetic. Cure time of 24 hours. SFX demo and activity using the kits to create wounds etc.
- **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G6. Make over day, application of prosthetics and make up using student kits, photos taken.
- **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 8.30 – 2.40pm** – Register in G6. Photo manipulation and end portrait printed.

Enrichment week for all students is **non-uniform**; however, sensible clothing must be worn. It would be very much appreciated if your son / daughter could bring in an old shirt or garment they will not mind getting "zombified". During the school day break time will be 10.30 – 10.50 and lunch will be 12.10 – 12.40, the canteen will be open as normal for students to purchase refreshments.
