What do I need to do?

How do I know what work I need to do?

Every day that you should be in school and you are not, you will need to **log on to** Classcharts. It is vital that you are keeping up to date with the essential work and revision that you need to do in preparation for your exams. If you have a smartphone, the easiest way to do this is via the app, or you can access the website.

How will I know what I need to do and when?

Whilst you are not in school, you should structure your timetable the same as you would do as if you were here. This means that if you should be in a maths lesson, you need to be doing maths work. What do I do if my log in for Classcharts does not work?

Firstly, check you are logging on correctly. You need to use the password we have given you. If you are still having difficulty, contact cenadmin@oakbank.org.uk and they will provide support.

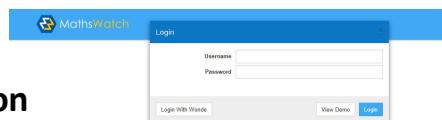
